World-class education and schooling system

Our schools offer a globally recognised curriculum, with a strong emphasis on critical thinking, creativity and developing lifelong skills. Western Australian students consistently perform well above international averages as assessed by the Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA). The curriculum offers 7 years of primary school (Pre-primary to Year 6) and 6 years of secondary school (Years 7 to 12), preparing students for seamless transitions into university, vocational training, or global careers.

International students can access English language support through tailored English language programs delivered by specialist staff, including students who are in the early stages of learning the English language.

Over 90% of our students graduate with the Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE). Australian education is recognised and respected by top universities worldwide. This recognition ensures that students who complete schooling are well-prepared for higher education, whether they choose to study in Australia or elsewhere.





Affordability and accessibility



Living with a host family helps students improve their English, build lifelong connections and immerse themselves in a supportive community. Students may also choose to live with a guardian.
